Northern Territory directors win Not-for-Profit Leader Scholarship

The Australian Institute of Company Directors is pleased to announce that five Territory directors and organisational leaders are recipients of the *2018 AICD Not-for-Profit Scholarships program*.

Under the program, the scholarship winners will undertake one of the AICD's highly-regarded education programs, including the *NFP Foundations of Directorship*.

The *AICD Not-for-Profit Scholarships program* forms part of the AICD's strong commitment to the NFP sector. Two-thirds of the AICD's 43,000-strong membership play some role in the not-for-profit sector.

AICD Northern Territory/South Australia Manager Clinton Jury congratulated the winners and wished them well in their studies.

"Not-for-Profit organisations play a vital role in the lives of our communities," he said.

"Public trust is the NFP sector's most valuable asset – anything we can do as an organisation to support directors taking an active approach to address trust through active governance education a critical step in ensuring the sector's ongoing success."
